

The New

Education Policy 2020-

A Much-needed Education Reform



When questions were asked about what could really be game changer for the future of India? I always thought about a major educational reform which could overcome the flaws of the current education system could really change the future of the country and also the lives of the people.

Just when the country was going through a worldwide pandemic and Indian is on mission of becoming self-reliant in the various business aspects and become global manufacturing hub putting China aside the Government of India comes with new education policy and finally brings some of the much-needed educational reforms. These reforms will play a big role in India's attempt to become a global manufacturing hub.

When it comes to skilled labour Indian stands nowhere close to its neighbour like China because of the education system followed in the country and lack of expenditure and attention by the government in the human resource development. There was also lack of expenditure in the field of research and development due to which multiple times the question was raised that why no new major technology or innovation comes from India even after having prestigious institutes like the IITs? Also, India produces an about 3/4th of million engineers in a year but still when it comes to the quality of skills these graduates possess it is questionable.

The new education policy will bring some of the major changes in the system which were needed from a long time. The new system will focus more on providing and testing practical knowledge rather than the textbook knowledge as in the current system. Mother tongue and regional language will also get the importance which they must be getting in the education system as will be the medium of instruction till class 5. There will be integration of teaching core concepts of the subject matter with vocational training allowing the students to possess multiple skills.

The whole idea is to create a multidisciplinary education system in terms of flexibility of subjects. This will create a pedagogical structure of curriculum with no rigid separations between streams. All the separation between vocational and academic and curricular and non-curricular will be removed. This will provide students to learn the subjects and skills of their own choice. Considering the rapid growth of information technology, the new policy will also introduce coding as a part of the syllabus from class 6 this will surely give India some fantastic coder and computer engineers.

The policy also includes the regulation of fees by the government by putting a fees cap. All the higher education institute will come under the same regulator except for law and medical. Apart from

this the policy also proposes multidisciplinary education and research universities, at par with the IITs and IIMs. This has been envisaged as models of best multidisciplinary education global standards in the country. The national research foundation will be created to foster domestic research and development. E-courses are to be created in the regional language and also national education technology forum to be created.

To summarise the major changes in the education system are as follows

- 📖 Complete overhaul of school system.
- 📖 Encouragement of art and cultural studies.
- 📖 Focus on practical knowledge and skills and not on textbook knowledge.
- 📖 Students will have the freedom to choose any subject they want to study and the demarcation between the rigid streams of science, arts and commerce will be removed.
- 📖 Push for a multidisciplinary education system
- 📖 Encouraging study of Sanskrit even in higher education.
- 📖 Common entrance examination for admission into colleges post school.
- 📖 Education to get a total of 6% of GDP.

Apart from these major changes some of the changes that I think which are still to be brought in the system are:

- 📖 Equality of the level of education for all i.e. everyone gets free and equal level of school education.


📖 Revision of history books and inclusion of Indian history, mythologies and their teaching in text books also a major description of the lives of freedom fighter which is not included and removal the manipulated history which is being taught.

📖 Removal caste-based reservation for the core of education system.

I hope to see these changes too in the education system soon. Although the major challenge which lies in front of the government is the transition from old education to a new one. It is going to be difficult for the government as well as the current population directly involved in the system to change into the new system but I think a sudden change would be big hit for all the students as well as the teachers. A period of 1 year must be given to set the whole new structure and prepare for the new format of curriculum this will without creating any problem will help in the transition.

These reforms are just right in time and again a great effort by the government in bring change in the nation from the core and will surely contribute to make India an economic super power and the government surely deserves a pat on their back for this.

FORENSIC AUDIT

A forensic audit is an independent and comprehensive process of reviewing a person's or the company's financial statements in order to determine if they are accurate.

OBJECTIVE

Forensic audit helps in avoiding fraud and theft and create a positive work environment.

A forensic auditor can ensure the integrity and transparency of financial statements by actively investigating for fraud, identifying areas of risk and associated fraud symptoms. So, It helps companies to prevent and detect fraud.

TYPES OF INVESTIGATION

The three categories of frauds are

CORRUPTION

There are three types of corruption fraud:

- ☑ In a conflict of interest fraud, the person exerts their influence to achieve a personal gain which adversely affects the company. It is not necessary that the person committing the fraud is benefited financially, but rather receives an undisclosed personal benefit as a result of the situation.
- ☑ Bribery is when money (or something else of value) is offered in order to influence a situation.
- ☑ Extortion is the opposite of bribery, and it happens when money is demanded (rather than

offered) in order to secure a particular outcome.

ASSET MISAPPROPRIATION

The most commonly committed frauds are those involving asset misappropriation, and there are many different types of fraud which fall into this category. For example:

- ☑ Cash theft - the stealing of physical cash, for example petty cash, from the premises of a company.
- ☑ Fraudulent disbursements - company funds being used to make fraudulent payments. Common examples include billing schemes, where payments are made to a fictitious supplier, and payroll schemes, where payments are made to fictitious employees.
- ☑ Misuse of assets - employees using company assets for their own personal interest.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT FRAUD

This is also known as fraudulent financial reporting, and is a type of fraud that causes a material misstatement in the financial statements. It can include deliberate falsification of accounting records; omission of transactions, balances or disclosures from the financial statements; or the misapplication of financial reporting standards.

This is often carried out with the intention of presenting the financial statements with a particular bias, For example concealing liabilities in

order to improve any analysis of liquidity and gearing.

TECHNIQUES AND TOOLS OF FORENSIC AUDIT

CRITICAL POINT AUDITING

Critical point auditing technique aims at filtering out the symptoms of fraud from regular and normal transactions in which they are mixed or concealed. For this purpose, financial statements, books, records, etc. are analysed mainly to find out:

- ✓ Trend-analysis by tabulating significant financial parameters.
- ✓ Unusual debits/credits in accounts normally closing to credits/debits respectively.
- ✓ Account/inventory discrepancies as evidenced from the unrecognized balance between financial records and corresponding subsidiary records (like physical verification statement, priced stores ledgers, personal ledgers, etc.)

PROPRIETY AUDIT

Propriety audit is conducted by Supreme Audit Institutions (SAI). In conducting the propriety audit, the core focus is on Value for Money audits aimed at lending assurance that economy, efficiency and efficacy have been achieved in the transactions for which expenditure has been incurred or revenue collected.

The same analogy, with modifications to the principles of propriety of public finance, applies in forensic audit to establish fraudulent intentions if any, on the part of the management. Financial frauds are results of wasteful, unwarranted and unfruitful expenditure from the monies available to the entity.

OTHER TOOLS FOR FORENSIC AUDIT

Conventional accounting tools like trend analysis, ratio analysis, fund flow analysis, cash movement analysis are to be supplemented by forensic technology for source data and few other forensic accounting tools like Relative Size factor, Surprise Repetitive Tests.

SCOPE OF FORENSIC ACCOUNTING

SCOPE IN INDIA:

- ✓ RBI Red Flagged Accounts needs forensic, in coming period RBI may make it compulsory for advances above certain threshold.
- ✓ Banks are now knocking the doors of the National Company Law Tribunal for further actions against the borrowers which are not paying their dues. Many of these cases are filed under the insolvency laws.
- ✓ Serious Fraud Investigations Office setup under Ministry of Corporate Affairs had many cases reported for fraud waiting to be investigated by Chartered Accountants.
- ✓ Big Multi National Companies have many incidences of internal fraud being reported which warrants an investigation.
- ✓ Also in case of mergers Forensic Investigation are conducted as a part of due diligence.
- ✓ Cyber Forensics is also an untapped field for Chartered Accountants.


It is not only what we do tangibly, but of the some time, mentally emotionally hurting people, like- He/She did this with me, she/he's gonna pay for it”






